#### **Overview**

Lomakatsi Restoration Project ([www.lomakatsi.org](http://www.lomakatsi.org)) is seeking to recruit and hire a qualified individual for the Restoration Operations Supervisor (ROS) position to be filled in February 2017. The selected person for this new position will join our expanding organization and team of specialists implementing large scale forest and watershed restoration initiatives. The successful candidate will serve a leadership role in the organizational structure of Lomakatsi's comprehensive Restoration Program operations.

Lomakatsi works with government agencies, tribal governments, forest-based communities and non-profit conservation organizations on collaborative forest and watershed restoration projects. These efforts work towards ecosystem resilience in the face of climate change, enhancement of fish and wildlife habitat, and abating the threat of severe wildfire. Lomakatsi provides expertise and capacity in project development, planning, management, fine-scale ecological treatment design, monitoring, and implementation; as well as integrating restoration practice with science delivery, education and workforce training. Lomakatsi coordinates with multiple funding partners and manages a diverse workforce in complex social settings supported by community outreach. Lomakatsi employs a multicultural workforce of 30+ restoration laborers and technicians, as well as 10+ restoration forestry contractors that are employed from the different communities where we work, providing several hundred additional jobs to restore thousands of acres.

The ROS supervises the day-to-day operations performed by Lomakatsi personnel, workforce, and hired subcontractors by overseeing the implementation of ecological forestry and riparian projects to successfully accomplish objectives. This person works under the leadership of the Restoration Program Director and provides an organizational link between Lomakatsi's restoration technicians, on-the-ground operations and contract administration.

- A minimum of 5 years of supervisory experience in personnel and project management with an aptitude for attending to human resources and employee policies and procedures
- Practical knowledge of ecosystem services and restoration implementation with the ability to manage and orchestrate the multifaceted business of on-the-ground forestry, riparian and habitat restoration operations
- Proven knowledge of workplace safety (OSHA), federal and state labor laws, and regulatory compliance
- Reliable communication skills with project planning, reporting and collaborative partnership engagement
- Effective leadership and "people-person" skill sets, with an attention to detail and multi-tasking in a dynamic, high-paced office work environment
